GREEN BONUSES & RENOVATING

The City of Brussels (postcodes 1000, 1020, 1120 and 1130) offers 9 bonuses to residents who manage their refuse better or make their neighbourhood greener. You receive a bonus for installing a compost bin or a green roof, for allowing rainwater to infiltrate the soil, for washable nappies, a fridge, a solar water heater, a rainwater butt, a rainwater tank and making the ground permeable.

Do your laundry in eco-mode! Despite the longer programme you save 30% on electricity. Cook passively and save 8 minutes of gas consumption. Boil water with a little salt and put your pasta, lentils, vegetables or rice in the water. Cook on the hob for 2 minutes then turn it off. Always leave the lid on the pan (don't stir) as it keeps the heat in. Follow the usual cooking time.

FIGHTING FOOD WASTE TOGETHER

Leftovers from your last meal? Offer them to local people using the OLIO app.

The **Froenten** app tells you which fruit and vegetables are seasonally available in your region. There are also storage tips and inspiring cooking ideas!

On the **Rekub** app, traders offer their food surpluses to consumers in the neighbourhood.

Tips

Drink tap water! Calculate how much money, plastic and CO2 you save at kraanwater.be.

It's also healthier than bottled water. 1 in 4 bottled water brands contain excessively high levels of fluorine, sulphate or sodium. Tap water is tested daily for chlorine, calcium, pesticides and heavy metals. Read more at gezondleven.be

The European Union has introduced the eco-score, a food label on which A is an eco-friendly choice while E represents a choice to avoid. The score takes the production method, origin, packaging and endangered species into account.
